
Paperclip Candy Canes



Activity:

- 3. Decorate the candy cane using coloured paper clips.
- 4. Hang it on the Christmas tree.

It Works on Skills Such As:

- Colour recognition.
- Task completion to increase attention and concentration
- Scissor skills to cut out the candy cane.
- Counting how many paperclips are on the candy canes.
- Fine motor skills to put the paper clips on.
- Use of both hands in tasks.
- Visual perception skills to create a pattern on the candy cane.

Tips:

- Laminate the candy cane for prolonged use over Christmas.
- Encourage cutting on a thicker marker for the younger children (it makes it easier) and use a thinner marker to make it more difficult.
